

KEY RIGHTS

- TAFE fees must be reimbursed or paid for by your employer.
- If you are 21 or older when you started your apprenticeship you are entitled to higher mature age wages.
 - You must be paid for all hours worked including overtime.
- As an apprentice you cannot be fired for exercising a workplace right or refusing to work in unsafe conditions.
 - Your employer has a duty of care to you as an apprentice, to make sure you are correctly supervised and not treated poorly at work.
