

The aim of the 2019 Jobs for Youth Campaign is to improve opportunities for young people across the inner northern region of Melbourne to gain local support, access to career information and assistance to increase job readiness skills and achieve life aspirations.

Connecting young people, schools, training organisations, community services and local employers through the campaign's activities, events and websites can make a big difference to employment outcomes for youth in the local region.

Whether you are leaving school soon or have already left, are currently studying, looking for a part-time job to help whilst studying, would like to start your own business, or get a full time job, the Jobs for Youth Campaign offers something for you.

There are lots of employment options in Melbourne's inner north – especially so if

you're interested in an apprenticeship. And just as importantly there are heaps of training opportunities that can help polish your skills and get you job-ready.

There are programs that enable you to pursue work placements in the area you're looking to work in, programs to help you put together your resume, and support services to guide you through your next job hunt.

The 2019 Jobs for Youth Campaign is an initiative of the Inner Northern Youth Employment Taskforce (INYET). This taskforce includes a wide range of local education providers, service organisations and business who work in the Darebin, Moreland and Yarra council areas. Together we are working to ensure young people in the inner north get the support they need to get started on a work journey.

JOB HUNTING

If you are still **at school**, your school's careers teacher is best placed to talk about career pathway options including further education and training pathways and job requirements. Ask about the Real Industry Job Interview (RIJI) Program, the 2019 Jobs for Youth Campaign Calendar of Events or work placement program.

If you have **left school**, you might continue into further studies such as TAFE or Uni or you'll head into the workforce. While getting a job can be tough if you don't have much experience, there are lots of options and opportunities, as well as plenty of places to get info to help. Often it's not what you know, but who you know, so make sure your **network of family and friends** understands that you're looking for a job.

EVENT DETAILS

POSITIVE PATHWAYS, BETTER FUTURES (CTS CONFERENCE)

This forum will explore how specialist schools and their communities can work together to improve post school career outcomes for young people with intellectual disabilities. Presentations and workshops will cover results of the 2018/19 post-school destination data collection and research projects, preparing school leavers for the employment landscape of tomorrow and explore examples of good practice within local schools and communities.

An interactive career event targeting years 8-10 students and parents/carers with information about future work in Melbourne's north. This event will target a number of local secondary schools in the inner north and allow young people to explore their strengths and skills and align these with emerging opportunities and pathways in various industries.

REAL INDUSTRY JOB INTERVIEWS (RIJI)

RIJI is a work readiness program that assists students from participating schools to develop good job search, resume writing and interviewing skills. The program is delivered as part of schools' curriculum throughout a series of guided lesson plans and culminates in a face-to-face interview with a local volunteer during a RIJI event.
