

VME Mentoring Matters (School-based, 3 options, 15 Roles)

A 10 week face-to-face vocational mentoring program that brings volunteers into the VCAL classroom once a week for up to two hours to work closely with a small group of 3 senior students. Through a range of activities and an excursion into industry, mentors will draw on their own life/work experience in Australia to support the students to complete their Career Action Plan, improve their transferable skills and work readiness.
