Led by young people

Students get to lead their own learning around the things that interest them - strengths based approach and genuine student voice. Having FUN!

Connected to community

Young people are making a difference to the things that they care about in their community - sense of purpose beyond themselves

Capabilities development

Students are engaged in authentic learning , developing a broad range of capabilities in a practical way

Entrepreneurial

Young people putting their ideas into action. They are 'doing' entrepreneurship in a real world context. A culture of entrepreneurship is developed in the school and community more broadly.

Dynamic and flexible

Teachers have easy access to resources that allows for flexible implementation in a fail safe environment - it is different for every school

Begin early in primary school and build consistently, year on year, throughout high school

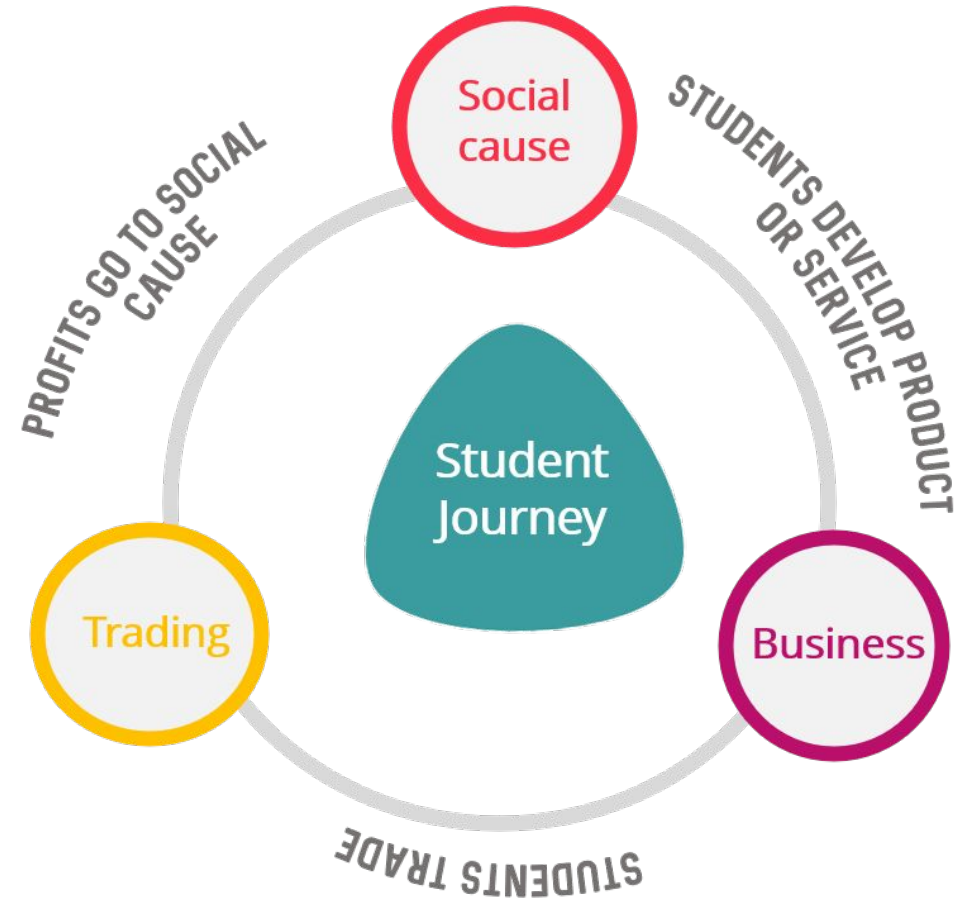
Be provided in ways that young people want to learn: through experience, immersion and with peers

Engage students, schools, industry and parents in codesigning opportunities in and outside the classroom

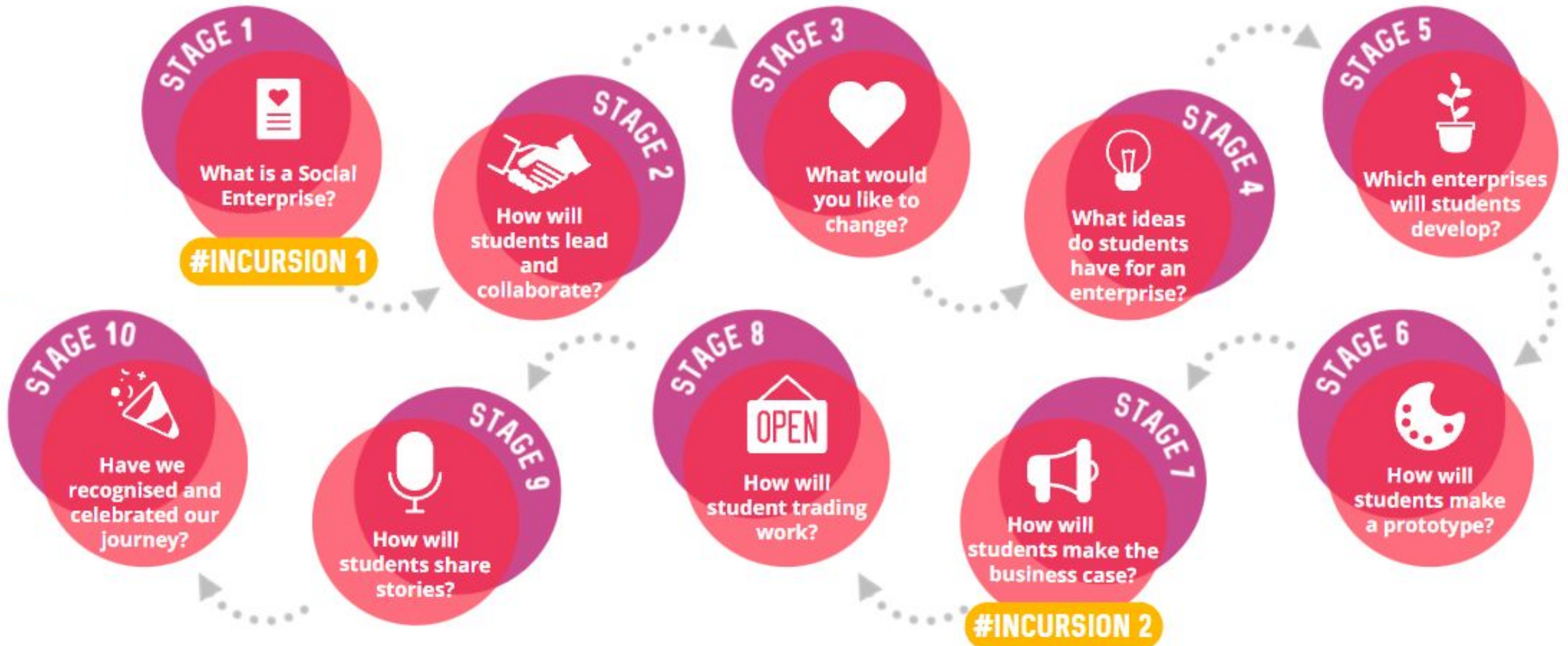
SOCIAL ENTERPRISE SCHOOLS

Is a **practical, student-led experience** that **develops enterprise and citizenship capabilities** while **building resilience in young people**.

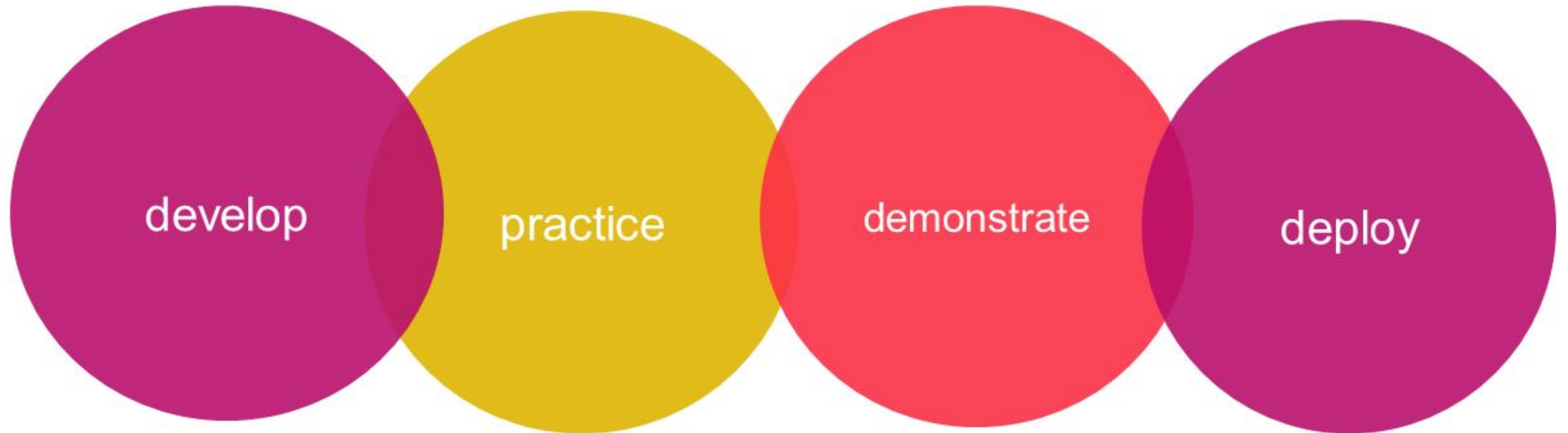
