WORK READINESS WORKSHOPS

- 1. Goal Setting Workshop** - work and life skill of setting goals and achieving them to build confidence.
- 2. Resume & Cover Letter Writing Workshop**
- 3. How to Choose & Steer Your Career / Achieving Career Goal Workshop** - guides Young People for successful transition into their dream career.
- 4. Finding Work after Study** best practice of job searching; how to present professionally, and set yourself up for interview success.
