Structured Workplace Learning (SWL)

is on-the-job training that allows students to develop their work skills and understand employer expectations. Host employers supervise and instruct the students as they practice and extend the industry skills they have learned in their VET programs. Students who undertake an SWL placement:

- Gain industry experience in a workplace setting.
- Practice important skills related to their VET program.
- Establish connections with employers.

Inner Northern Local Learning & Employment Network (INLLEN) is an independent community organisation which develops partnerships and strategies to support young people across Darebin, Merri-Bek and Yarra to successfully move from school to further education, training and employment.

What's involved?

- **Who:** Year 10-12 students undertaking a VET program
- **How:** Offer 5 - 10 day placement
- **Flexible arrangement:** 1 day per week or in blocks
- **Cost:** \$5 per day minimum *excludes not-for-profit
- **Administration:** Free administrative support from INLLEN
- **Legal/Risk:** Insurance is covered by the Department of Education
